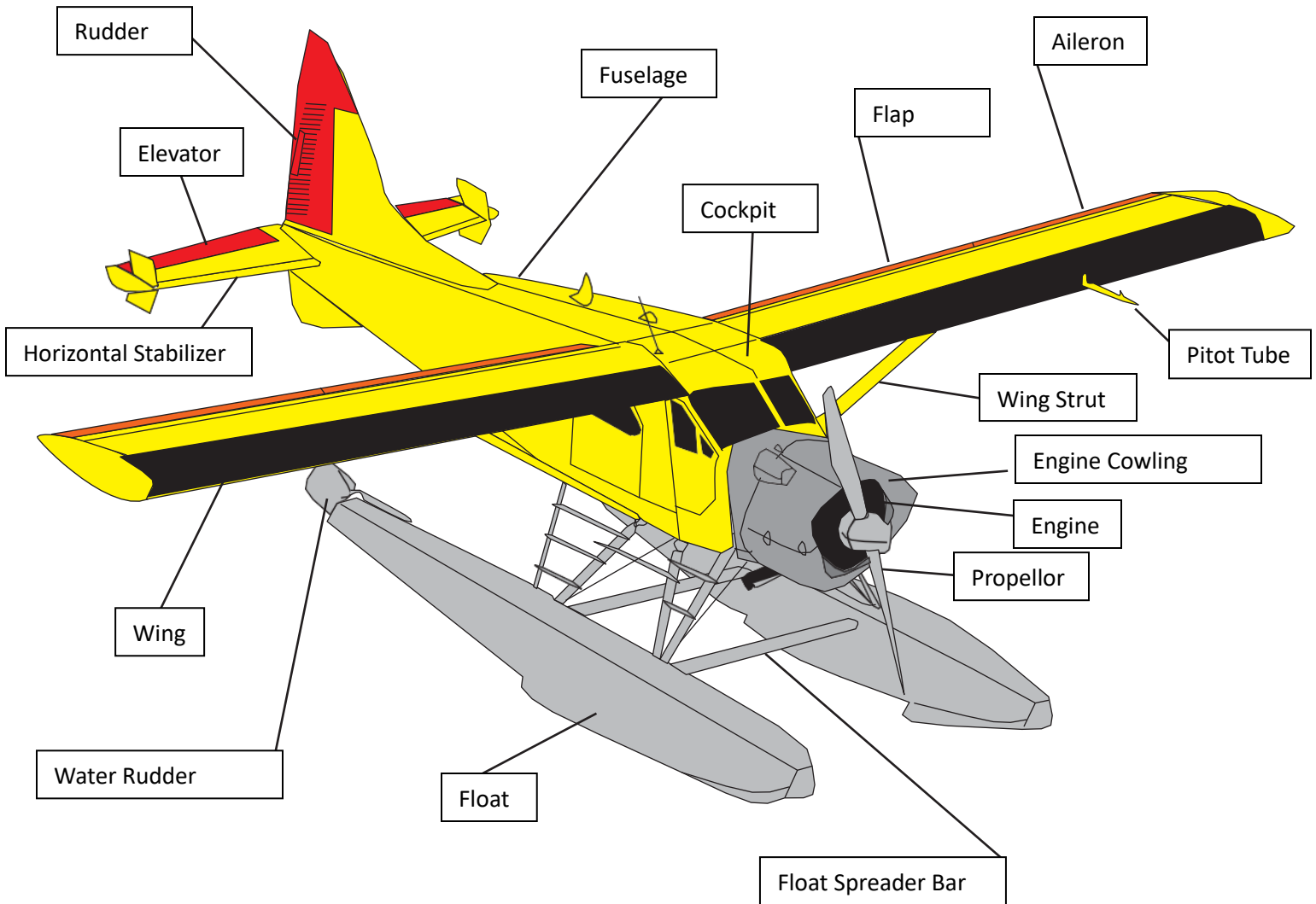


# Activity Sheet: Parts of an Airplane
